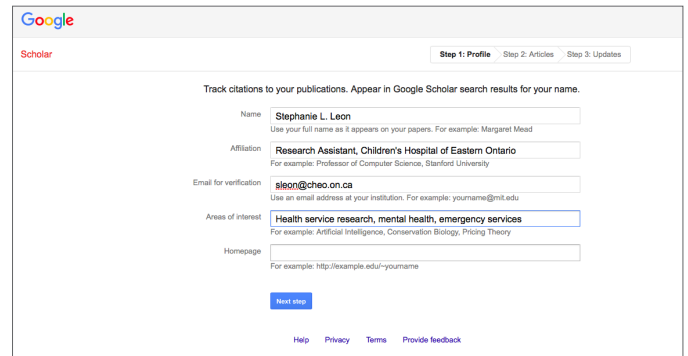
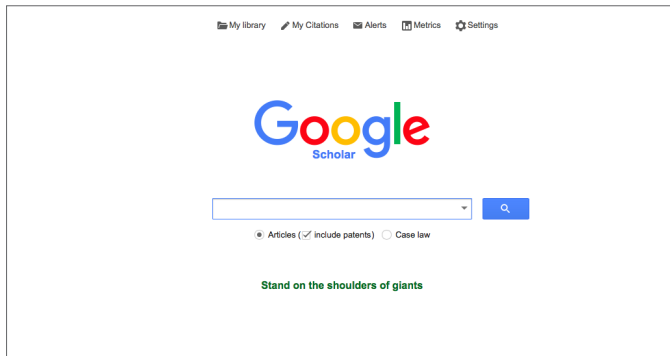


Automatically creating a bibliography with Google Scholar, and importing it to UNIWeb

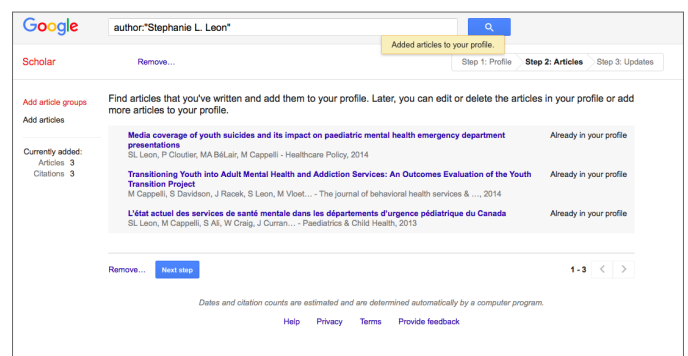
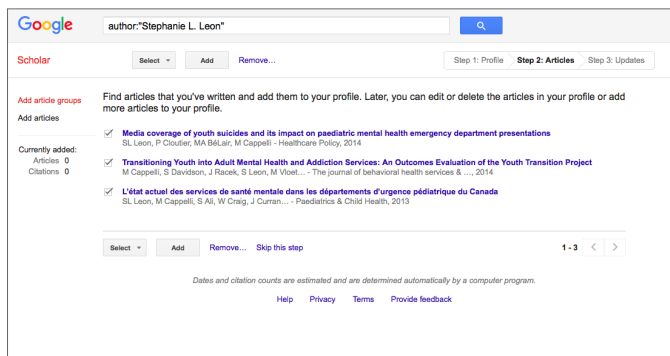


1. Set up your account

Setting up your Google Scholar account and transferring your publication data into UNIWeb is easy and only takes a few minutes (if you already have a Google Scholar account, skip to step 7). To create a Google Scholar account, go to the Google Scholar home page: google.scholar.ca and click on "My Citations" at the top of the screen.

2. Create your profile

Fill in the information (your name, affiliation, email, etc.) to create your profile. When you are done, click on "Next step."



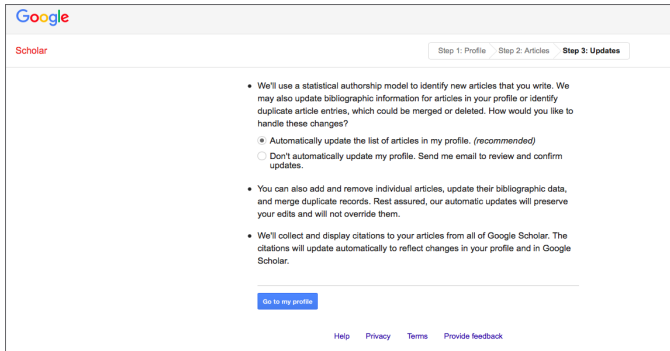
3. Watch your data come in!

Within seconds, Google Scholar will collect the reference data from all of your publications that can be found on the internet; you will see them listed before you. Select the articles that Google Scholar has found from the web. Click "Add."

4. Next step

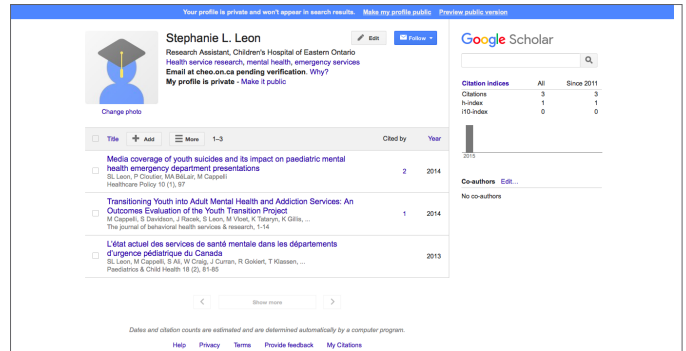
Once the articles have been added, click on "Next step," and find your newly created Google Scholar account with all of your publications' reference data.

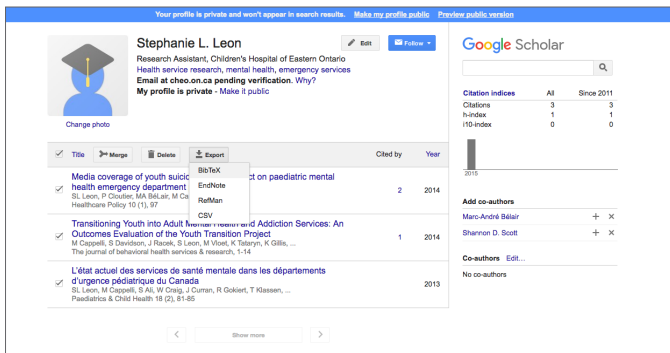
5. See your profile

Click on "Go to my profile" to see your Google Scholar account with your publications.



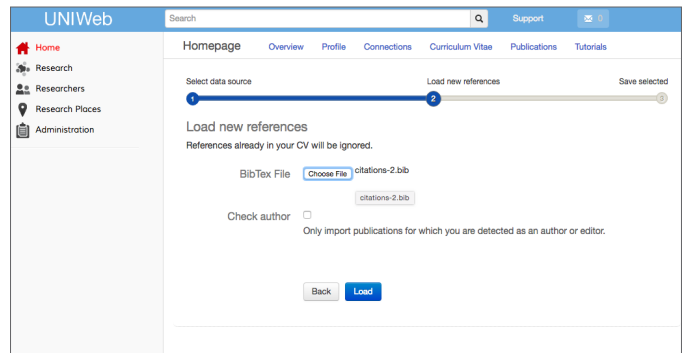
6. Use your account

You now have a Google Scholar account with access to different tools (e.g., your h-index and citations count), and the option to make your profile public.



7. Download BibTeX file

In order to export your Google Scholar references into UNIWeb, you will need to download them as a BibTeX file. Select all references by clicking in the box to the right of "Title." Then click "Export" and select the BibTeX file type.



8. Import into UNIWeb

Your file will download onto your computer, and it will then be ready for importation into UNIWeb. From here, you can log into your UNIWeb account and, under "Publications," select "Import Publications," where you will select the BibTeX file that you just downloaded; this will automatically bring all of your reference data from Google Scholar into UNIWeb.

Tip: Check Google Scholar regularly to find new references and import them into UNIWeb.
